Dear Chairman Scott and Ranking Member McMorris Rodgers:

On behalf of our 38 million members and all older Americans nationwide, AARP is pleased to endorse your bipartisan *Transformation to Competitive Integrated Employment Act*. This legislation would phase out subminimum wages for people with disabilities and allow them to earn fair compensation.

Competitive employment provides dignity and independence and improves workers' long-term financial security. People with disabilities should not be treated differently or be paid less than non-disabled employees. This bill takes an important step in abolishing subminimum wages for people with disabilities by eliminating certificate holders under section 14(c) of the Fair Labor Standards Act over five years.
