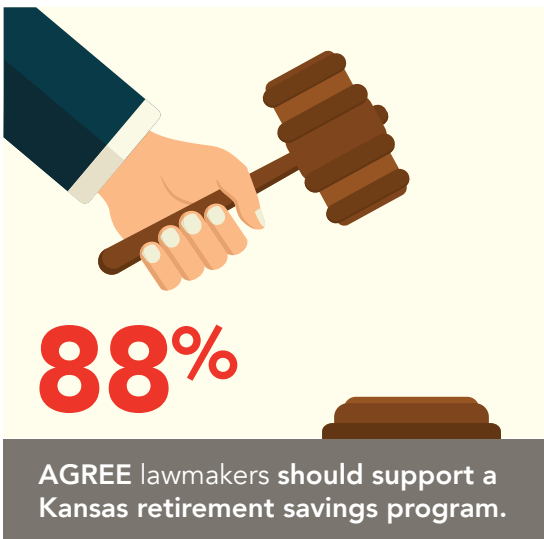


KANSAS WANTS TO SAVE

Kansas Registered Voters Support a Retirement Savings Option



88% believe it is **very important** to be able to **save for retirement at work**.



85% of workers without **access to a workplace savings program** would **take advantage of one** if it were available.

Kansas Registered Voters Feel Anxious and Behind Schedule About Retirement



74% are concerned that **cost-of-living increases** may **reduce their standard of living in retirement**.



41% are **not confident** that they will be able to **cover healthcare expenses** in their retirement years.
