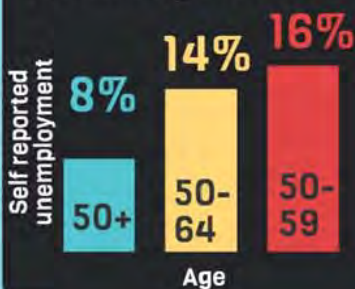
ISSUES THAT MATTER TO NYC VOTERS AGE 50+

METHODOLOGY: These data were collected in a telephone survey of 1,302 New York City registered voters age 50 and older. Interviews were conducted between May 17 and June 30, 2013 in English and Spanish. Data have been weighted by borough, age, gender and race/ethnicity to reflect the 50 and older voter population in New York City. The total sample has a margin of error of ±2.7 percent.
