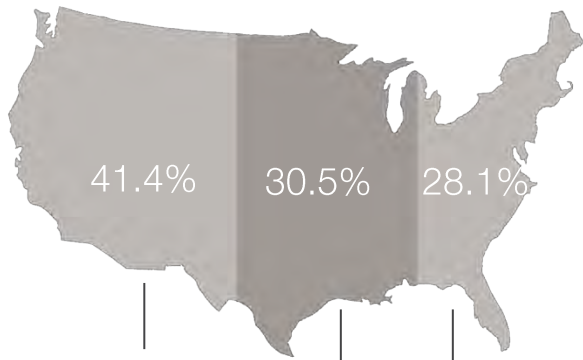


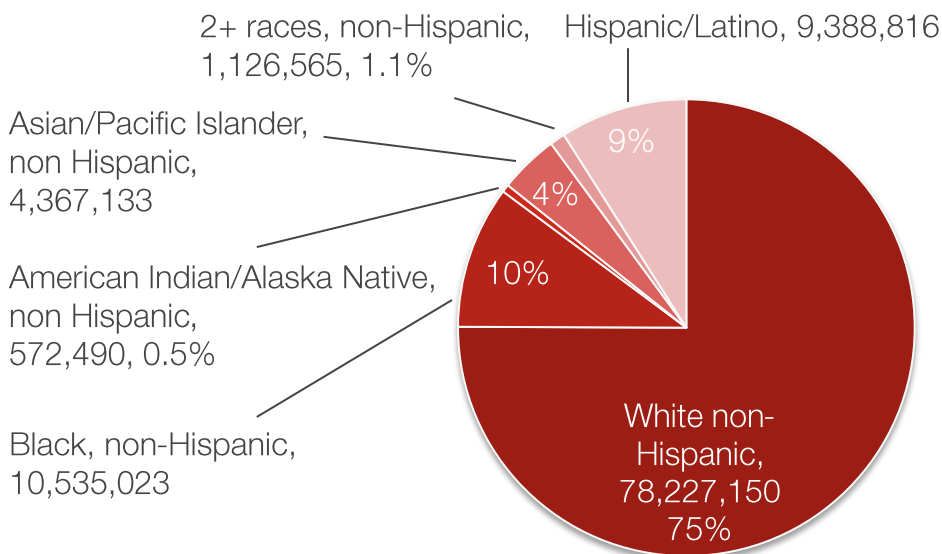

Diversity Among Older Adults



The **Pacific region** (CA, WA, OR) is the most diverse region for adults over 50:

- **17.5%** of adults age 50+ there are **Hispanic/Latino**
- **13.3%** are **Asian/Pacific Islander**
- **4.7%** are **Black/African American**

3% are **small business owners**¹

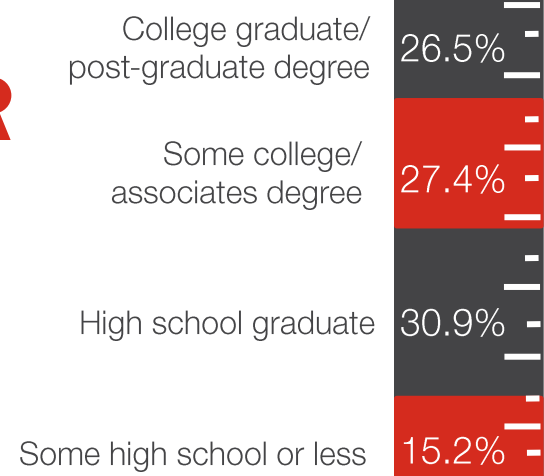
5% of adults ages 50-59 **work from home** most days¹

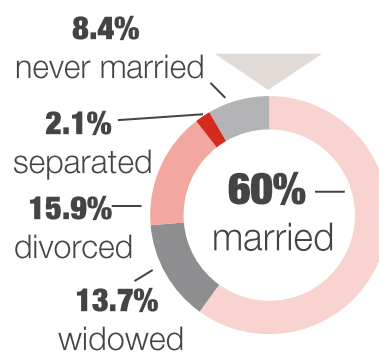


2%: # of the 50+ who go back to school¹
