1 in 6 Minnesota residents receive Social Security



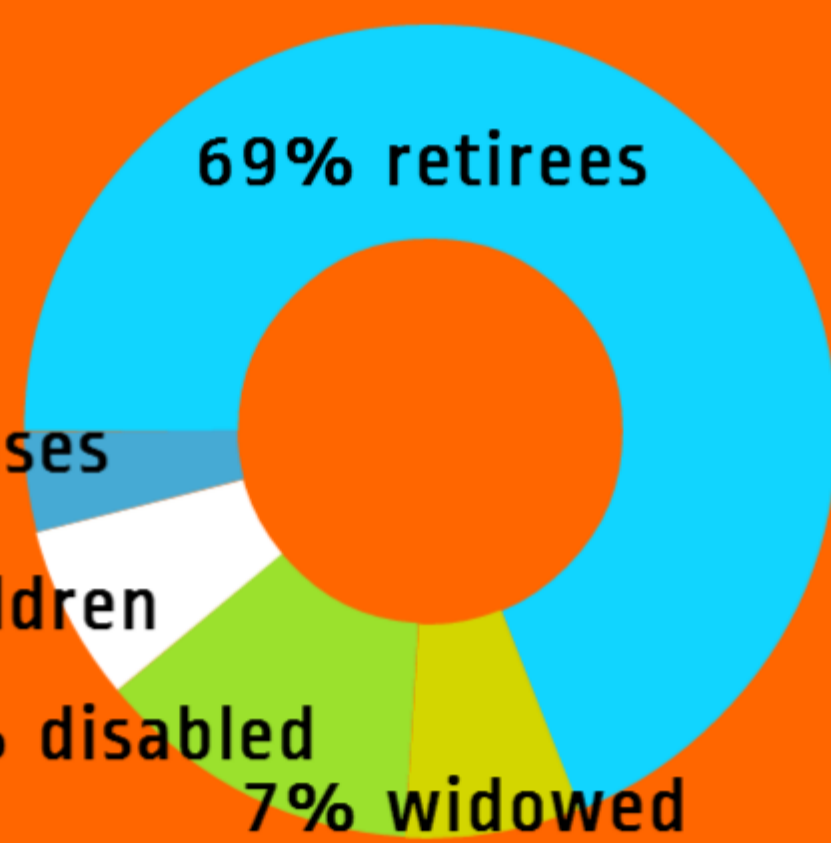
In 2012, Minnesota's population was about 5.4 million, with 730,000 being age 65+

Minnesota Social Security Beneficiaries



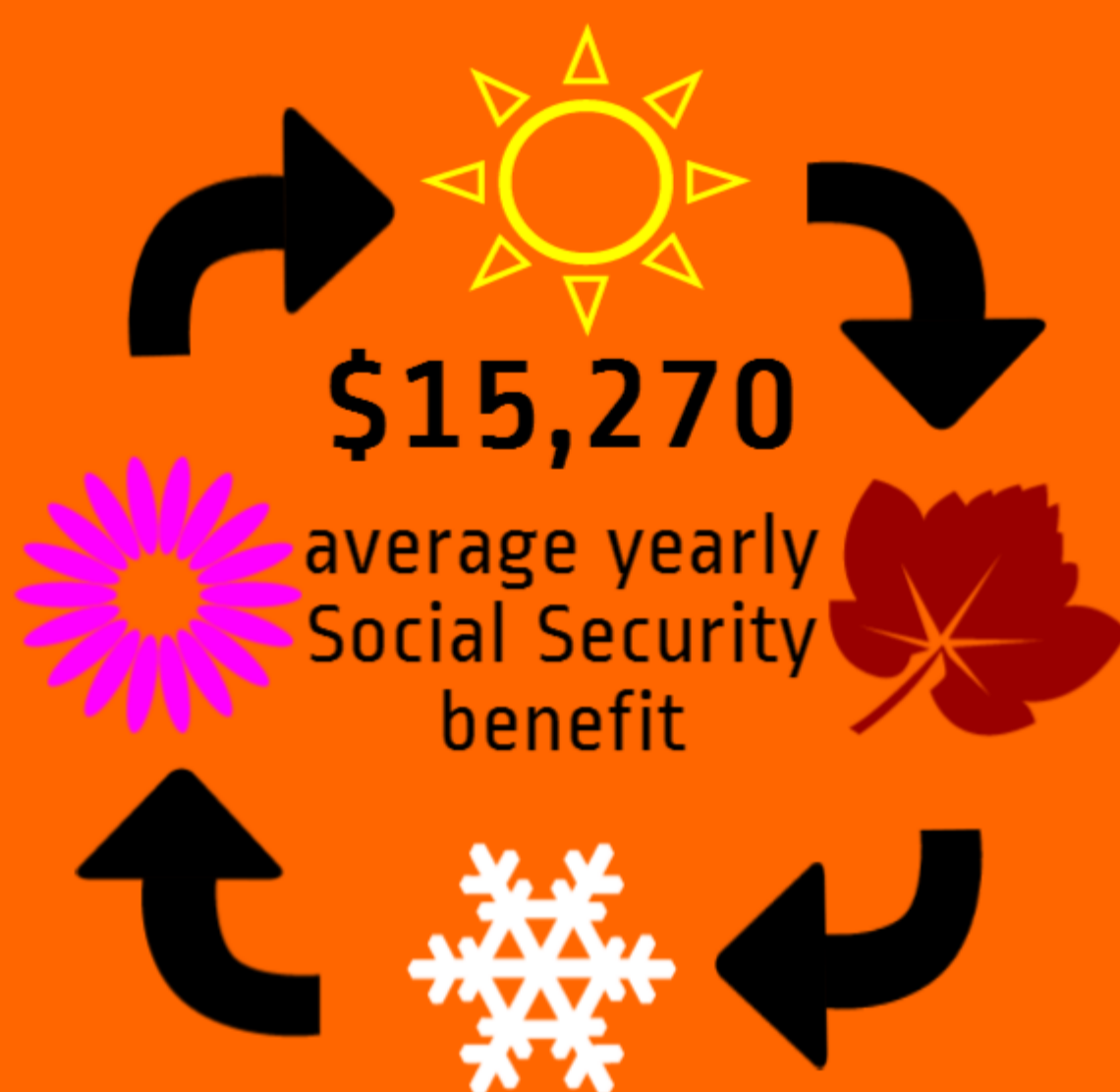
Social Security generates \$24.7 billion dollars in economic output for Minnesota

\$1,272 average monthly Social Security benefit



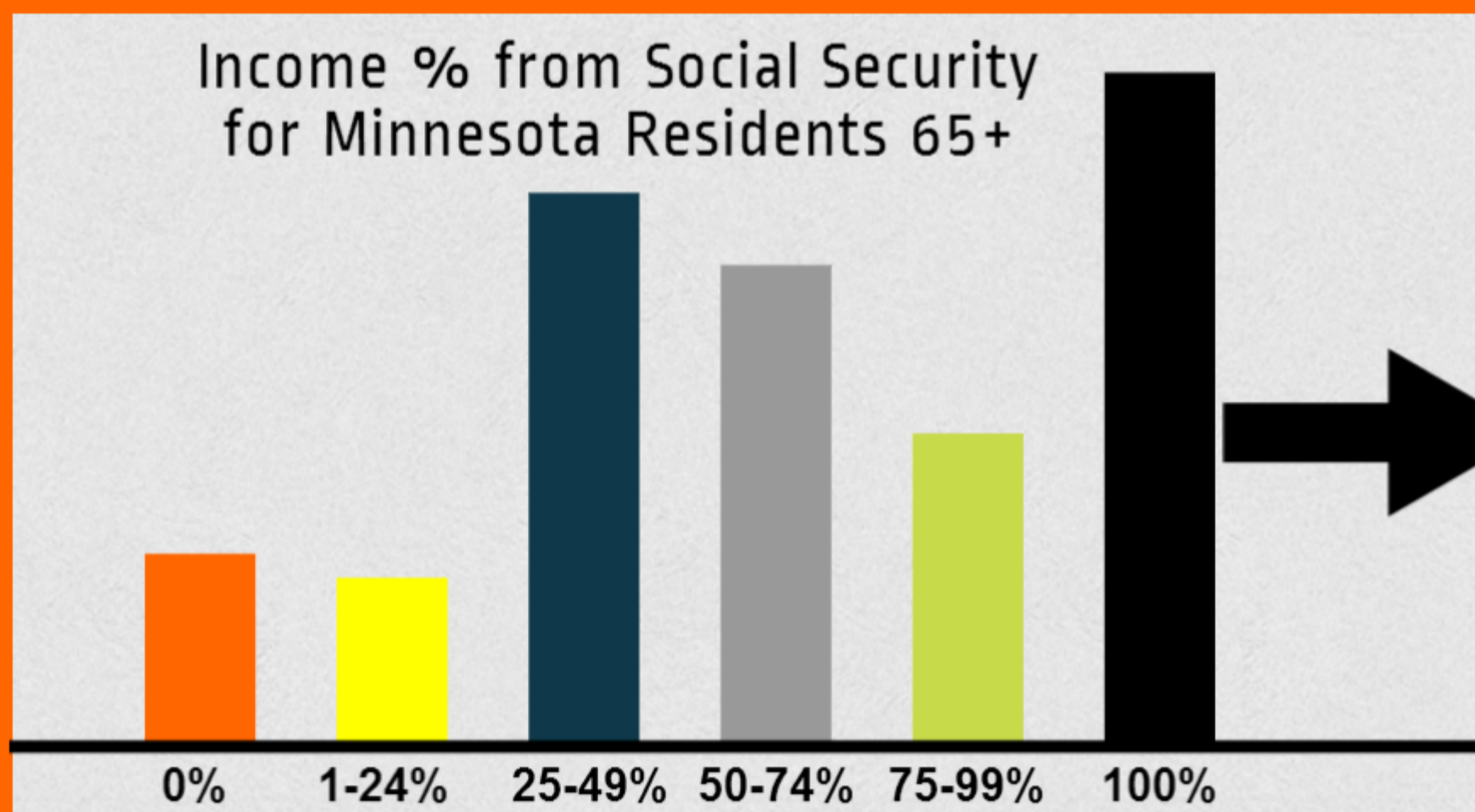
Social Security lifts 267,000 Minnesotan retirees from poverty
