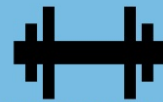
**HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS WHO SPEAK DIFFERENT LANGUAGES**

78.6% say it is important to have health care professionals who speak different languages including American Sign Language (ASL). Only 44.6% say this is present in their community; resulting in a gap of 34%.

### MOST IMPORTANT FEATURE

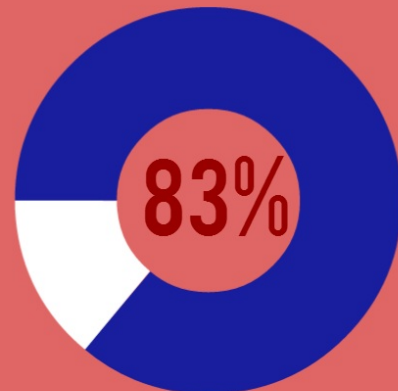
**WELL-MAINTAINED HOSPITALS AND HEALTH CARE FACILITIES**
