### COMMUNITY INFORMATION DELIVERED IN PERSON

88.1% say it is important to have community information that is delivered in person to people who may have difficulty or may not be able to leave their home. Only 12.1% say this is present in their community; resulting in a gap of 76.0%.

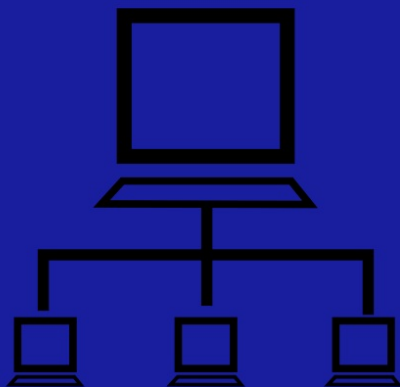

### MOST IMPORTANT FEATURES



Free access to computers and the Internet in public places (65%) and access to information in one central source (65%) are the most important features to Orleans County residents age 45-plus.



### LARGEST MET NEED



The lowest unmet need is free access to computers and the Internet in public places such as the library, senior centers or government buildings. 88.0% say it is important to have this feature in the community. 74.2% say this is present in their community; resulting in a small gap of 13.8%.
