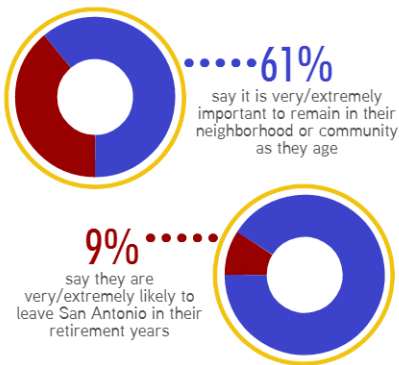




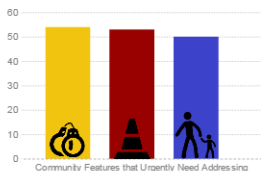

ISSUES TO ADDRESS

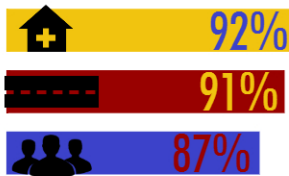
Of the community features that are key to ensuring a high quality of life for older residents...






the top 3 issues that urgently need addressing are:

-  neighborhood safety
-  well-maintained roads/streets
-  adequate sidewalks and street crossings

COMMUNITY FEATURES



The top 3 important community features to San Antonio Hispanic residents age 45-64 are:

-  good health care facilities/services
-  streets that are safe for all users
-  community support/services to help older residents live independently in their homes

LARGEST UNMET NEED

Respondents were asked how important the neighborhood features and services were to them. They were then asked if these features and services existed in their neighborhood. These questions were then paired together to identify neighborhood unmet needs or "gaps".

Community support and services that help older residents live independently is the largest unmet need (-33%) identified by Hispanic residents ages 45-64
