

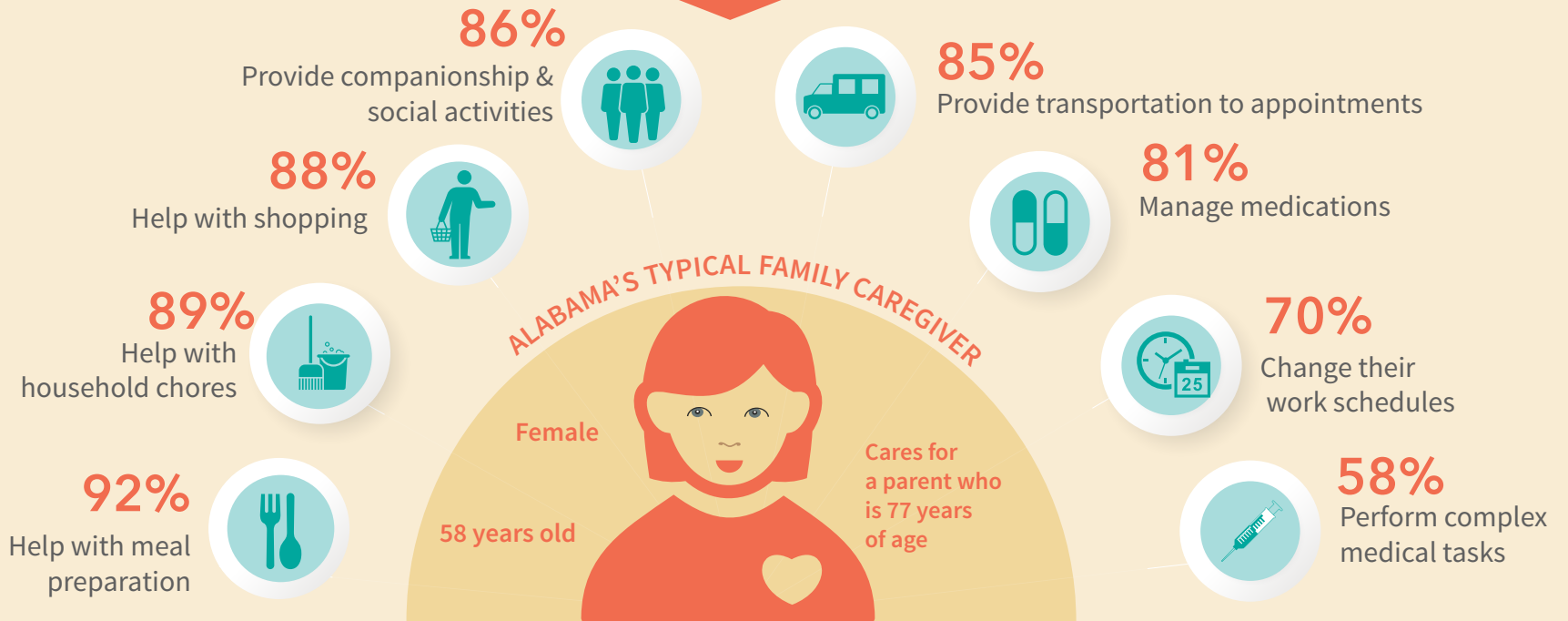
ALABAMIANS ARE FAMILY CAREGIVERS

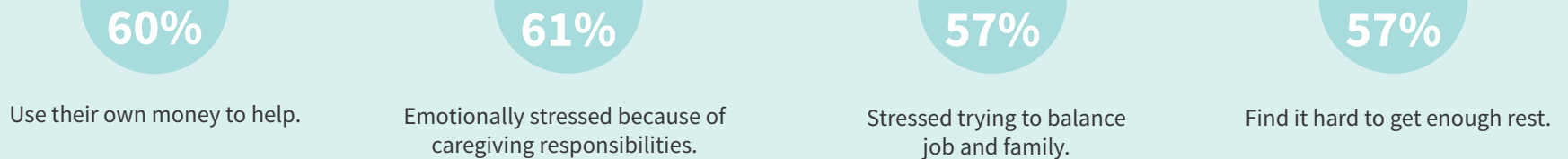
48%  Current or Former Caregivers
