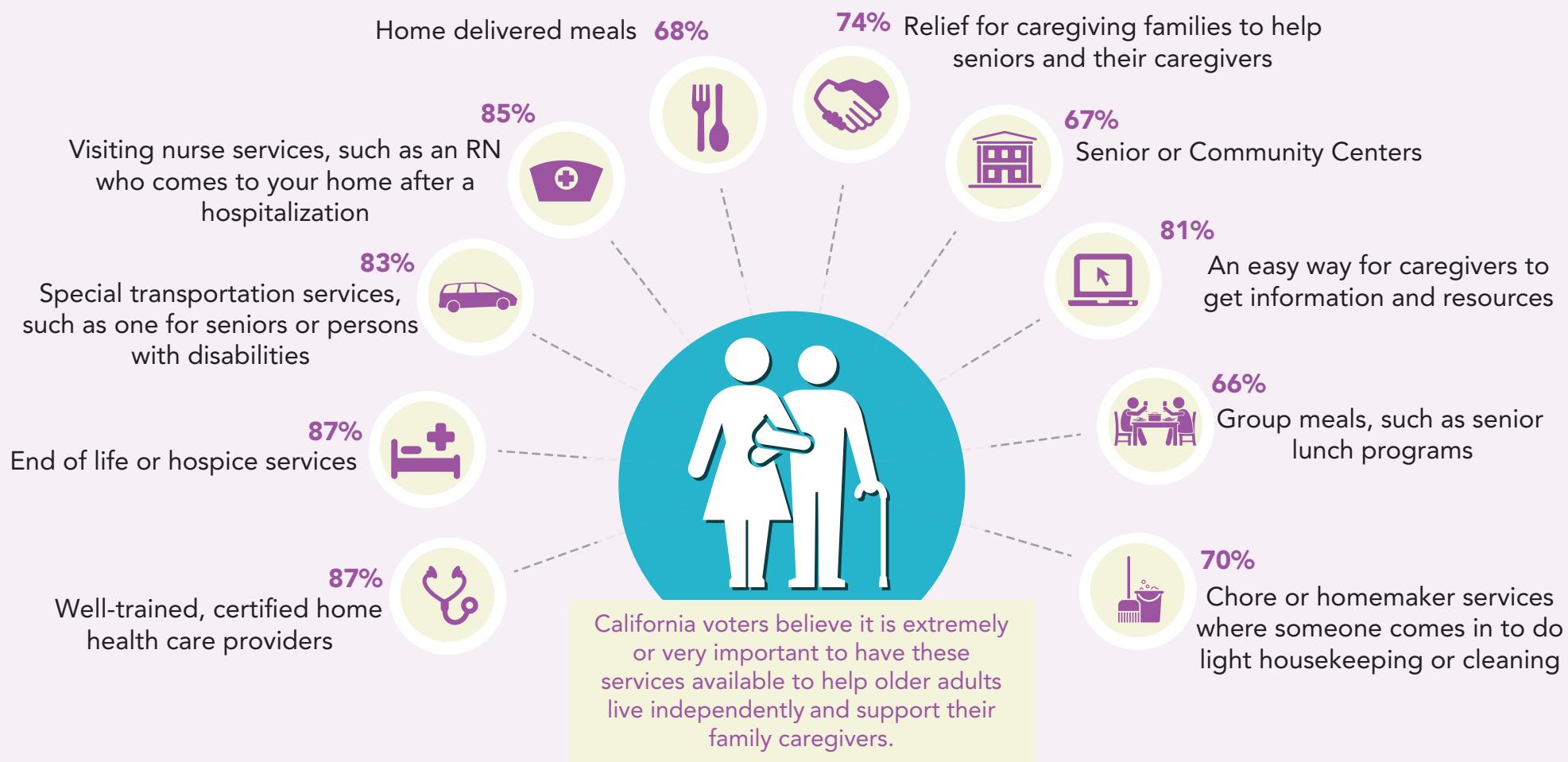


# CALIFORNIANS OVERWHELMINGLY SUPPORT HELPING OLDER CALIFORNIANS REMAIN AT HOME LONGER



The strong majority of registered voters age 40+ in California (82%), across party lines, want home- and community-based services that enable older Californians to live independently at home. This critical, lower-cost care that older Californians and their family caregivers, count on includes home delivered meals, aides, transportation, and more.



# CALIFORNIANS WANT SUPPORT TO HELP SENIORS LIVE AT HOME



Nearly all (94%) California voters believe resources and training for family caregivers are important. Additionally, current, former, and future family caregivers think specific supports would be helpful:
