

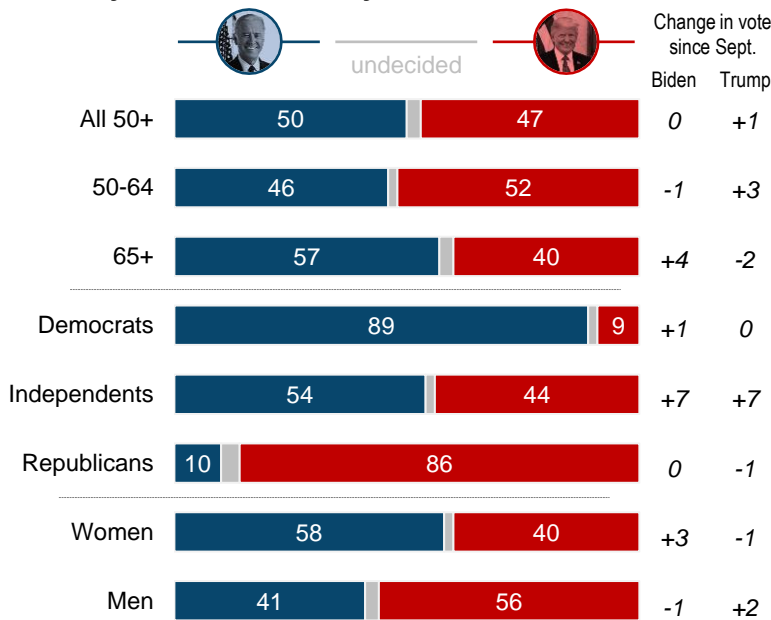
50+ Likely Voters in Pennsylvania

Key Findings:

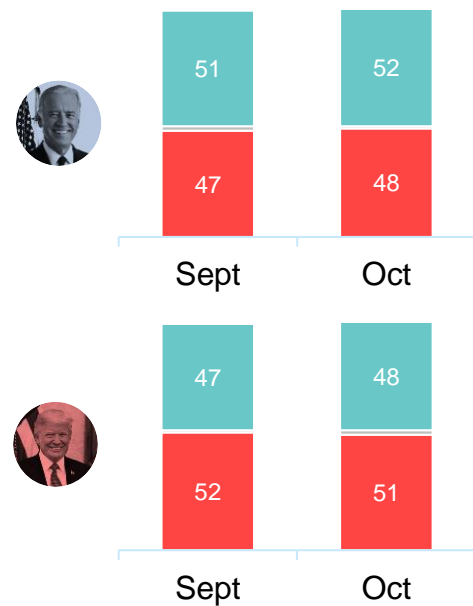
- **Voters 65+ are the key swing:** The race has narrowed very marginally, and Vice President Biden has a 3-point lead over President Trump with older voters – driven by voters 65+ who support Biden by a 17-point margin.
- **Virus concerns increasing:** As the country faces another wave of coronavirus increases, 62% of voters 50+ are worried about catching the virus – up 7% since September, largely driven by 65+ (+12) and Biden voters (+13).
- Though 50+ voters narrowly trust Trump more on rebuilding the economy, they trust Biden more on more personal financial issues like making health care more affordable, strengthening Social Security and Medicare, and looking out for middle- and working-class people. They also trust Biden more on coronavirus.
- **Vote-by-mail is in full swing:** Nearly two-thirds of Biden voters have either already voted by mail (25%) or plan to vote by mail before Election Day (40%), while only 9% of Trump voters plan to vote before Election Day.

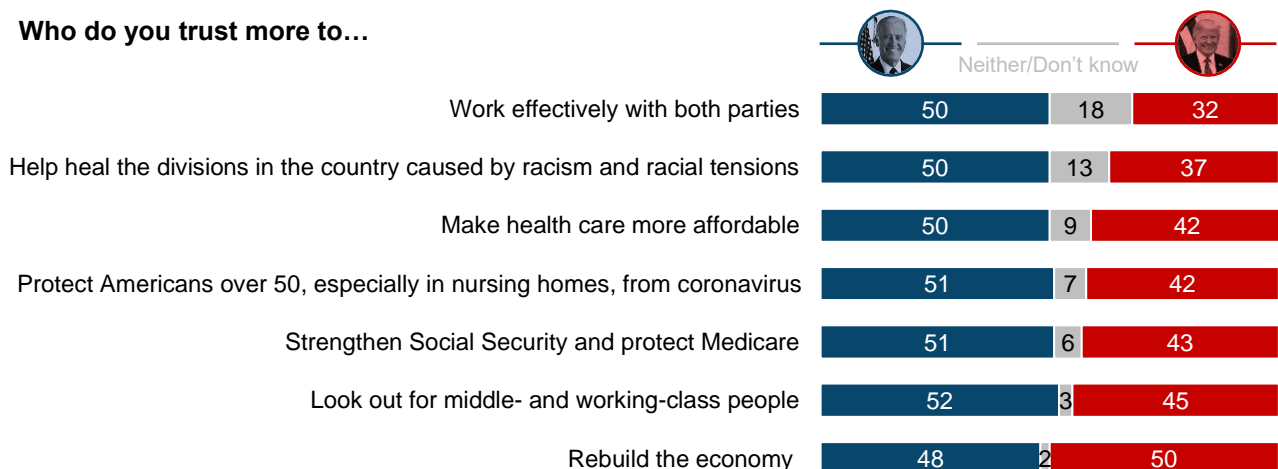
Now, if the election for President were held today...for whom would you vote?

Who do you trust more to...



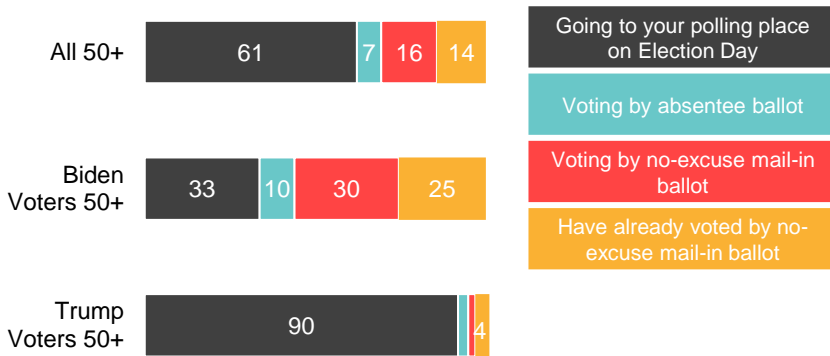
78% of Biden voters 50+ are **extremely motivated to vote for Biden** –
No change from Sept.

77% of Trump voters 50+ are **extremely motivated to vote for Trump** –
+3 points from Sept.

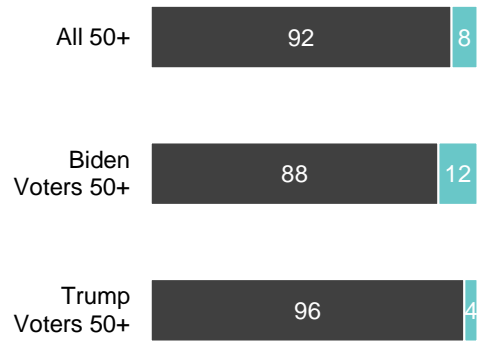
97% of Biden voters 50+ are **worried about Trump winning the election** –
+3 from Sept.

84% of Trump voters 50+ are **worried about Biden winning the election** –
+5 points from Sept.

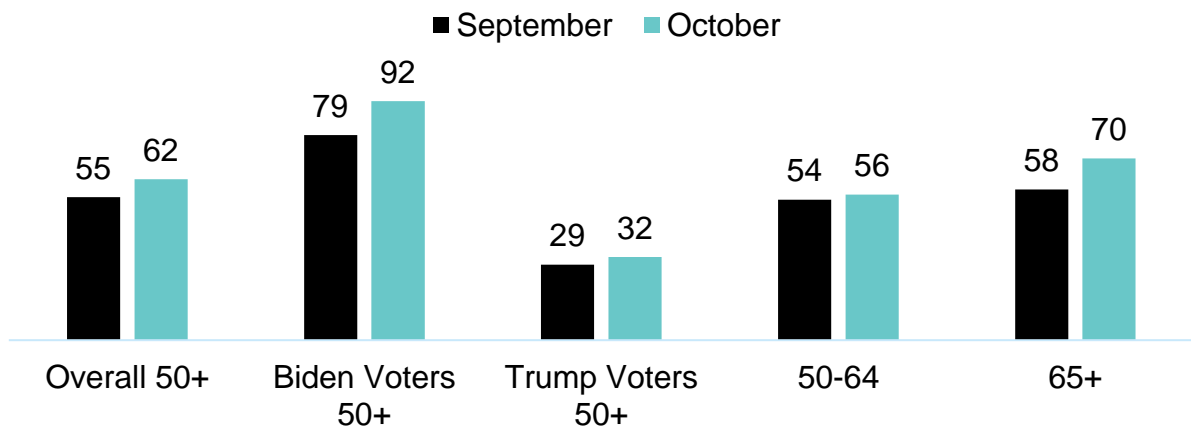
In this November's general election, do you intend to vote by...

How worried are you about getting coronavirus ?

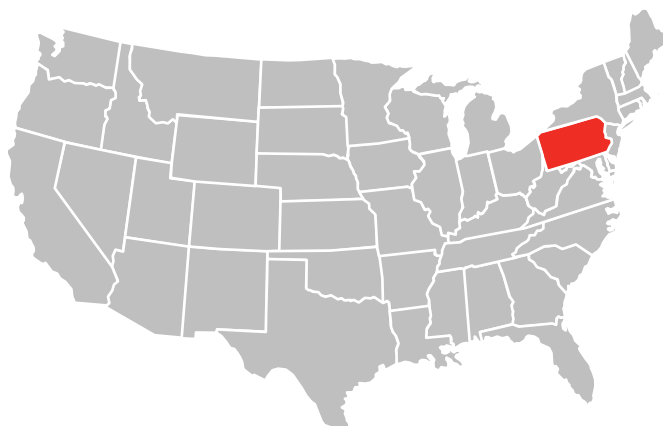


Methodology



Benenson Strategy Group conducted 683 interviews – by phone and SMS, using registered voter lists – with likely 2020 voters age 50+ in Pennsylvania from October 13th to October 15th.

Data was weighed to ensure it was representative of the likely voting universe of 50+ voters.



The margin of sampling error for the entire data set is $\pm 3.75\%$ at the 95% confidence level.

Due to rounding, answer choices may not always add up to 100%.

Note: All reported data is among 50+ likely voters except when otherwise specified.

Partisan crosstabs in this report represent how people are registered.

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
